

Directions to Sustainable Settings – Getting There:

There is an airport in Aspen (ASE), and in Denver (DEN);

CME, Colorado Mountain Express, is a shuttle serving the Front Range through Aspen, Glenwood Springs, and Carbondale. For their schedules and rates visit <http://www.cmex.com/querieschedules.asp>; better yet call them at 1-800-525-6363 as the website is a bit confusing. There is a shuttle from the Denver International Airport to Carbondale, with three shuttles per day. Please allow about five hours for travel from Denver to Carbondale.

The nearest Amtrak station is in Glenwood Springs, 18 mi. north of Carbondale; There is a Greyhound stop in Glenwood Springs. Roaring Fork Valley Service (RFTA) is a transit bus service with multiple departure times from Glenwood, Aspen and Basalt <http://www.rfta.com/spring/valley.html>

Taxis are also available.

If driving: From I-70, exit at Glenwood Springs (Exit 116) and take State Highway 82 towards Aspen & Carbondale. In Carbondale, at the intersection of State Highways 82 & 133, head south (toward Mt. Sopris) on Highway 133, for 6.1 miles. Thompson Creek Ranch is on the right hand (west) side of Highway 133. Look for a cluster of ranch buildings and the mail box, which has Sustainable Settings written on it. Enter the drive and pull ahead.

To park (if the front gate happens to be closed, feel free to pull in and close it behind you, as we have livestock within). We look forward to seeing you.
